The paper is very well written and very organized. The methods and numerical approaches are very clear, and the discussions are valid. My only suggestion is to improve the quality of equations 1 to 6. I believe they were pasted as images rather than using math formulations.

Reviewer 2

This is a good paper presenting the application of a fracture mechanics based model to predict the structural behaviour of fiber reinforced and hybrid reinforced concrete beams.

We kindly remind you that you need to submit the **copy-right form** in order to publish the full paper in the symposium proceedings book until the deadline **31 March 2023**. Please note that this deadline is absolute and strict for us to be able to deliver the proceedings book which will be published by Springer and indexed by WoS and Scopus, at the symposium.

It should also be emphasized that the papers of the authors, who are not registered until **31 March 2023** will not be included in the symposium proceedings. The authors who only submitted an abstract also need to be registered until **31 March 2023** in order to publish their abstract in the symposium Abstract Book. **We would like to note that one full registration covers the presentation/publication of a maximum of two papers and a student registration covers the presentation/publication of one paper.**
