I am writing to invite Prof. Yu Sing Leung (Jonathan) to visit the School of Biological Sciences, The University of Adelaide (UoA), as a visitor from 31 July 2024 to 30 November 2024. Depending on his time and schedule, we plan to study the effect of ocean acidification on starfish in his visit, as my current ARC Discovery grant on climate change benefits from the past work done jointly with Prof. Leung. By continuing our collaboration, we seek prestigious papers and grants of high value to both Shantou University and UoA. Thus, I am glad to continue to work with him in the future and look forward to seeing him in Adelaide again soon.
